34 (14%) of 240 households are headed by widowed men
40 (17%) are over 60 with adult children (multi-generational households)
8 are veterans
Discharged soldiers are likely to have been involved in the Napoleonic Wars.
Napoleon occupied Vienna in 1809.
No households are headed by women

Author's notes

This is the author's transcription of the original 1828 Hungarian Land Census available on microfilm from the LDS, #0623060
The original document is in Latin. An English translation is available on microfilm from the LDS, #1573238, listing only house numbers and names.
Pomogy appears on pages 58 and 59 of this document.
Column headings are as translated in the appendix of 1573238 document, although that document doesn't include any of that information.
First names are listed as Anglicized, surnames as they appear in the original document.
The second column shows the names as translated in the 1573238 document.
Bracketed houses are shared structures probably similar to duplexes
Writing is not always legible. Mistakes may be made.
Any notes are translated to the best of the author's ability.
There are several pages of observations from the census taker written in Latin following these entries
Column categories 7, 8 and 9 are for meadows, vineyards, and orchards. There are no entries for Pamhagen in these categories.
Column category 12 is forest ownership and annual nut yield. There are no entries for Pamhagen in this category.
